***Do your volunteers feel equipped? Are they looking for a way to grow in their knowledge of the Word or in their leadership experience?*** The Illinois School of Ministry is opening its doors for anyone wishing to pursue adult continuing education courses for a Certificate in Biblical Training.

This program allows church leaders to pick any four courses from our current offering of 24 subjects, customizing their education to meet their specific passion and area of ministry. **What Does it Cost:** Each course cost \$80.00 plus a shipping and handling fee of \$5. In addition, there is a one-time enrollment fee which allows us to setup a student account with Global University (\$20 if previously enrolled with Global University; \$30 if a new student to Global University).

Courses may be purchased individually or all at once. After the four courses have been completed, Pick 4 students may decide at any time to complete the next level of training – preparation for Certified Minister certification.
