The Illinois School of Ministry is opening its doors for anyone wishing to pursue adult continuing education courses for a Certificate in Biblical Training.

This program allows church leaders to pick any 4 courses from our current offering of 24 subjects, customizing their education to meet their specific passion and area of ministry. What Does it Cost: Each course cost \$80.00 plus a shipping and handling fee of \$5. In addition, there is a one-time enrollment fee which allows us to setup a student account with Global University (\$20 if previously enrolled with Global University; \$30 if a new student to Global University).

Courses may be purchased individually or all at once. After the four courses have been completed, Pick 4 students may decide at any time to complete the next level of training, preparation for Certified Minister.
